Connect to NDM Wireless Network

Windows 7

| Select | NDM_ResNet |
| Select | Connect Automatically checkbox |
| Click | Connect and choose "Public Network" when the "Set Network Location" pop-up appears. |

Windows 8/8.1

| Move | The mouse to the bottom right corner of the screen and click Settings  |
| Click | The wireless icon |
| Select | NDM_ResNet |
| Select | Connect Automatically checkbox |
| Click | Connect |

Windows 10

| Click | The Wireless icon in the system tray.  |
| Select | NDM_ResNet. |
| Select | Connect Automatically checkbox. |
| Click | Connect. |

The icon will change to show that a connection has been established.

Windows Vista

| Click | Start > Connect To |
| Select | NDM_ResNet |
| Click | Connect |
| Click | Connect Anyway |

A window will pop up showing an established connection.

Mac OSX

| Click | "Turn AirPort on" icon  |
| Select | "Turn AirPort On" |
| Click | NDM_ResNet |
